

LEGIS Rider Bonus Program: Progressive Show Jumping

The LEGIS Rider Bonus is an awards program that provides cash rewards to Hunter Derby riders who win two or more designated classes in a series on the same horse. The program is sponsored by LEGISequine.com, #HorsemenInsuringHorsemen. The 2023 Progressive Show Jumping Shows are included in the South Carolina LEGIS Rider Bonus Program.

Up to \$1,000 of Hunter Rider bonus money is available in the 2' Derby!

\$250 to any rider who wins two of the designated classes \$500 to any rider who wins three of the designated classes \$750 to any rider who wins four of the designated classes \$1,000 to any rider who wins five of the designated classes

Up to \$2,000 of Hunter Rider bonus money is available in the 2'6" Derby!

\$250 to any rider who wins two of the designated classes \$500 to any rider who wins three of the designated classes \$1,000 to any rider who wins four of the designated classes \$2,000 to any rider who wins five of the designated classes

Rules:

- Results will be tracked and posted online at www.LEGISequine.com on the Rider Bonus page.
- Results will be tracked as horse and rider combinations in the designated classes above.
- The LEGIS Rider Bonus is paid to the rider, and riders must complete a W9 before the bonus money will be issued.
- A rider will be paid a maximum of the largest bonus won throughout the season. For example, if a rider wins two 2' derby classes on the same horse, that rider will receive \$250.
- If that same rider wins a third class in the series, that rider will receive an additional \$250 for a total of \$500.
- Multiple riders may win a LEGIS Rider Bonus in a given season. For example, a rider may win two hunter derbies and another rider may win three hunter derbies in the same series. In both cases, each rider will be paid the corresponding bonus amount.
- Any disputes or discrepancies will be decided by the LEGIS Rider Bonus Committee.
