



2026 LEGIS Awards at PSJ C Series Shows

2'0" and 2'6" PSJ Child/Adult Hunter Derbies

\$250 awarded to top three overall horse and rider pairs in each height section during the 2026 show season. Points will be awarded: 6-4-3-2-1. In case of a tie, the pair with the most first place finishes breaks the tie.

LEGIS will provide ribbons and prize money to the top three overall in each height section as follows: \$125 - \$75 - \$50

LEGIS PSJ Crossrail Horsemanship Challenge

A three-phase competition held at PSJ's medal finals show (November 14-15, 2026)

Phase 1: Flat Equitation

Phase 2: Handy Hunter

Phase 3: Horsemanship Quiz.

Point Calculation: Riders will earn points in each of the three phases and the rider with the highest overall score will be named the champion. In case of a tie, the Horsemanship Quiz will serve as the tie-breaker, with the Flat Equitation as the second tie breaker.

Each phase will be worth a maximum of 100 points. The judge of the Flat Equitation Phase will award a score to each rider, which will not be announced. The judge of the Handy Hunter Phase will award a score to each rider, which will not be announced. The Horsemanship Quiz will have a maximum possible score of 100.

Ribbons and awards through sixth will be presented during the PSJ Awards Banquet.

LEGIS Clear Round Challenge: Progressive Rider .80m Jr/Am Jumpers

Awarded to the rider with the most clear rounds in the Progressive Rider .80m Junior/Amateur Jumpers during the current show season. This is a rider award for juniors and amateurs.

Rules: If a rider competes multiple horses in a class, **only the rider's best score counts**. This is a **rider award** and it is not horse specific. If there is a tie, the rider with the highest percentage of clear rounds based on total rounds competed in will be named the winner.

Example:

- Two riders each have ten clear rounds.
- Rider 1 competes in 20 classes during the year and Rider 2 competes in 30 classes during the year.
- Rider 1 has a 50% clear round completion rate compared to Rider 2 who has a 33% completion rate. Rider 1 is named the winner.

LEGIS will present ribbons and awards through sixth at the awards banquet in November.

LEGIS Progressive Rider Clear Round Trainer Vacation

The trainer of the leading rider in the Clear Round Challenge will be awarded a four day, three night Marriott Vacation Club vacation anywhere in the United States.

LEGIS PSJ Medal Final Trainer Vacations

Presented to the trainers of the PSJ Pony Medal Final, PSJ Junior Medal Final, and PSJ Adult Medal Final champions. Each trainers will be awarded a four day, three night Marriott Vacation Club vacation anywhere in the United States.
